DECISION ON ACCUSED'S MOTION TO SUBPOENA RADIVOJE MILETIĆ

On 9 May 2013, the Chamber granted the Defence motion and issued a subpoena against Radivoje Miletić, currently detained at the UN Detention Unit in The Hague, in order to testify in this case. The expected date for his testimony is 9 July 2013.
